- Create, harmonize and track compliance to schedules to ensure that milestones are met
- Set priorities, and manage the communication and harmonization of these priorities
- Support budget preparation and provide associated visibility (Budget vs Spend etc)
- Prepare and present progress reports to management as required
- Actively support the Achieving Excellence (AE) departmental objectives

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's or Master's degree in Aircraft Avionics or Electrical Engineering from an accredited university or equivalent.
- A minimum of 8 years of relevant experience and technical expertise (design, development, integration, certification) and people management and development.
- You have a working knowledge of wiring design, installation and/or wiring integration. You are also familiar with ECAD tools and processes.
- You must have excellent communication skills. Bilingualism is considered an asset.
- Knowledge of CATIA V5 is also an asset.
- High sense of commitment and willingness to accept responsibilities while acting independently in a high-pressure team environment.
